

ACCOMMODATIONS INFORMATION

A number of options exist for housing during the Karst Field Studies courses in the Mammoth Cave region. These include:

Hamilton Valley Bunkhouse/Dormitory: This facility is where the class lectures will be held. Hot showers, kitchen facilities (including refrigerators, stoves, and basic kitchen utensils and cooking equipment), and bunks are available at this site. 10 bunkrooms with 4 bunks per room are available. Because there will likely be two classes going on simultaneously during the week of your class, the bunk rooms may be nearly full. The cost for this accommodation option is \$12.00 per bunk, per night. Bunks are reserved on a first-come, first-serve basis, so please arrive early to choose your bunk bed.

Hamilton Valley Camping: A camping area will be available at Hamilton Valley for \$12.00 per night. Hot showers and kitchen facilities will also be available for campers.

Mammoth Cave Hotel: Located across the Green River from Hamilton Valley, these accommodations are situated near the Historic Entrance at Mammoth Cave. Arrangements for the hotel must be made by the participants, but your lodging selection must be conveyed to the KFS program director.

Cave City Area Hotels: There are other hotels available near the I-65 in Cave City. Arrangements for the hotel must be made by the participants, but your lodging selection must be conveyed to the KFS program director.
